[Brian Williams Missing Person](#) is the son of Betty (Elizabeth) and Jack Williams, he was born in Adelaide, SA on 22.12.1937, he would be 75 years of age.

Brian has an ALIAS ~ Brian Henry WATSON, he could also be known to use any of these names, Brian, Victor, Henry, George Russell, Ralph, Williams... Steven or Stephen Williams or 'Bungy' Williams.

Brian went 'MISSING' in mid 1971, he has not been seen since but he told his sister that he was on his way to Perth, WA. His family believe Brian made contact with his mother in 1989 via phone call asking 'are you ok, is everything alright?' His mother said she recognized his voice. Brian also had contact with the police in Adelaide, SA in 1989.

Brian was employed in South Australia at Woomera Rocket Range (what is now known as The RAAF Woomera Test Range) before he enlisted in the Royal Australian Navy. Brian is a Vietnam Veteran, he joined the RAN on 28.7.1958 and was discharged 20.3.1969. Brian served in Vietnam from the 27.5.1965 ~ 26.6.1965 and 20.9.1965 ~ 3.10.1965 on the HMAS Duchess and 8.2.1969 ~ 25.2.1969 on the HMAS Sydney. Brian was a chief petty officer, he was a Gunner and a Navy Diver.

Brian is bald, he has a plate for four of his top teeth with a gold cap. Brian also has a steel plate in his head from a motorcycle accident, he has various tattoos to identify him, including a geisha girl and an anchor on his arms, he also has a rose on his chest with the names Pat, Kim and Pam.
